What is the significance of the Epiphany and the Season that follows? The word *Epiphany* means "manifestation" or "a revealing". Since light helps to

reveal and make manifest, on January 6 we recall the Magi led by the light of the star to the manger to worship Jesus, "the Light of the World" given birth by Mary. We will go on in the Season that follows to commemorate the manifestation of the Trinity at Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan River, where the voice of the Father spoke, and the Holy Spirit descended and alighted on Jesus as he came forth from the river. The voice identifies Jesus as God's Son in whom the Father is well pleased. The Season after the Epiphany closes with the Transfiguration whereby a future glimpse of the Resurrected glory of Christ was revealed.
