If you have never participated in a Bible Study, and likewise have read very little of the Scriptures, you are not alone! This is true for many folks, even among those who have attended church services all their lives

Not being well acquainted with the Bible is why many are reluctant to join a Bible Study. After all, who wants to be exposed for what they don't know. Similarly, it is not unusual to be clueless in how to begin and go about reading the Bible. Without a guide, it is not an easy book to read!

Of course, there is a remedy for all this. And a good place to start is with your Pastor. That is what I am
