Promise: that sharing in our humanity God's Son accomplishes our salvation Pastor Timothy A. Duesenberg Isaiah 7:10-17; Psalm 24; Romans 1:1-7; <u>Matthew 1:18-25</u> (Fourth Sunday in Advent, 12/22/19)

Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. -v. 20

Lead In – My third year of seminary was one of internship in the northwestern Wisconsin town of Amery on the Apple River. It was a good year, but not an easy one. I remember a clergy gathering in the area that December in which I as an intern, was the only one confessing belief in the Virgin Birth of our Lord Jesus...

Parting Shot – It has been said that Jesus paid a debt that He did not owe, because we owed a debt we could not repay. And that is one way of getting at the mystery. But I want to stick with the idea of an infection. Picture the saying "one bad apple spoils the whole bunch". Indeed, if rotting fruit is not removed... Picture the reverse of this... That one totally good apple will make good the whole bunch. But it needs to be a totally good apple!...

Is 7:10-11 Again the LORD spoke to Ahaz, "Ask a sign of the LORD your God; let it be deep as Sheol or high as heaven."

Is 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Is 7:16 For before the boy knows how to refuse the evil and choose the good, the land whose two kings you dread will be deserted.

The Birth of Jesus Christ

¹⁸Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. ²⁰But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." ²²All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: ²³ "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us). ²⁴When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, ²⁵but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus.

Ro 5:12 Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned

Ro 5:15 But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many.
