Parting Shot – I think I get it why we want to find loopholes and contradictions. That way we can avoid the parts that illumine and we fear to be true. G.K. Chesterton once said... It is tough to be exposed. There is a lot we want to keep hidden. But the disease won't go away because we are ignoring it. There is a physician who claims to be able to be able to heal it. It involves going under and then awakening post-surgery. And this surgeon has gone under himself in death and demonstrate the healing He is able to provide by conquering sin, death, and the power of the devil. For He claims to be one with, and the Son of, the God of the living.

Famous modern Atheist Authors: Richard Dawkins, Christopher Hitchens, Daniel Dennett, and Sam Harris. Dawkins is an English ethologist, and evolutionary biologist; author of "The God Delusion" and "Outgrowing God: A Beginner's Guide".

Sadducees: Party of the high priests, noble families, merchants. Held to first 5 Books as authoritative. Did not accept tradition of scribes and Pharisees: not believing in resurrection or angels.

John 3:19 And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their deeds were evil.

Deut 25:5-6 "If brothers dwell together, and one of them dies and has no son, the wife of the dead man shall not be married outside the family to a stranger. Her husband's brother shall go in to her and take her as his wife and perform the duty of a husband's brother to her. And the first son whom she bears shall succeed to the name of his dead brother, that his name may not be blotted out of Israel

Sadducees Ask About the Resurrection

²⁷There came to him some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, ²⁸and they asked him a question, saying, "Teacher, Moses wrote for us that if a man's brother dies, having a wife but no children, the man must take the widow and raise up offspring for his brother. ²⁹Now there were seven brothers. The first took a wife, and died without children. ³⁰And the second ³¹and the third took her, and likewise all seven left no children and died. ³²Afterward the woman also died. ³³In the resurrection, therefore, whose wife will the woman be? For the seven had her as wife."

³⁴And Jesus said to them. "The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage, 35but those who are considered worthy to attain to that age and to the resurrection from the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage, ³⁶ for they cannot die anymore, because they are equal to angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection. 37But that the dead are raised, even Moses showed, in the passage about the bush, where he calls the Lord the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob. ³⁸Now he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for all live to him." ³⁹Then some of the scribes answered, "Teacher, you have spoken well." 40For they no longer dared to ask him any gues-

Exodus 3:6 And he said, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.
